

Accounting (736)**Grade 12****CPI**

An elective course in which students will learn to analyze and record business transactions and prepare financial records. Topics will include accounting ethics, adjusting entries, posting to ledger accounts and preparing payroll records.

Business Today (737)**Grade 12****CPI**

An elective course designed for any student who has an interest in learning about the world of business. Topics will include economics, ethics, finance, globalization, human resources, management, marketing and ownership.

Honors Business Today (738)**Grade 12****Honors**

An elective course in which students will explore the nature of business today including changes affecting business nationally and internationally. This course will expose students to the activities, decisions, problems and successes involved in business and is recommended to students pursuing a degree in any business discipline. Prerequisite: Recommendation of English or Social Studies Teacher in junior year.

Personal Finance (739)**Grade 12****CPI**

A financial literacy course designed to help each senior make informed decisions about spending, saving, borrowing and investing in order to build a solid foundation for their financial security. A required course for every senior which will meet one day per week.
